

The Sue Reilly Scholarship Fund

The Sue Reilly Scholarship Fund is designed to provide tuition assistance to qualifying families enrolled at Piedmont Progressive Preschool. As a nonprofit organization, our school relies on fundraising initiatives and community support to sustain and grow the Sue Reilly Scholarship Fund each year.

Scholarships are awarded in accordance with the following policies and procedures:

- A maximum of two scholarships will be awarded each academic year.
 - The school's preference is to provide scholarship assistance to two separate families whenever possible. However, if only one qualifying family applies during a given school year, both scholarship awards may be applied to two children within the same family.
- Applications will be reviewed and awarded on a first-come, first-served basis, contingent upon available funding.
- Scholarship award amounts will be determined according to the applicant's annual gross household income, as outlined in the school's approved sliding scale tuition chart.

- To be considered for scholarship assistance, applicants must submit a completed scholarship application along with the following required supporting documentation: • Two recent pay stubs for each employed member of the household; and • A copy of the household's most recent federal income tax return (Form 1040). • Applications will be reviewed by the School Director and a designated voting council member. Applicants will be notified of the committee's decision in a timely manner.

Incomplete applications or applications submitted without the required documentation may not be considered for funding.
